

NRC in Syria

NRC is in Syria to support people affected by forced displacement (IDPs, returnees, host community etc.) so that they can have access to timely and effective assistance, to cope with the crisis and when the crisis ends return and rebuild their lives. Since the start of its activities in mid-2016 in Syria, NRC has reached with humanitarian assistance to more than **600,000 people** particularly in the Governorates of Damascus, Aleppo, Qoneitra, Dara'a, Hama, Hassake and Rif Damascus, out of which more than 152,000 people reached in 2020 with the provision of more than 255,000 services and moving forward to reach more during 2021.

NRC will continue to apply an integrated programming approach, where Education, capacity building, Shelter/WASH, and Food Security and Livelihoods (FSL) programmes work jointly to enable displacement-affected populations to meet their basic needs, enjoy their rights, and benefit from pathways to durable solutions.

- 1. Identify funding opportunities and develop proposals to ensure the implementation of NRC's strategy and objectives in the country regarding education.
- 2. Review project proposals and reports in order to ensure the technical quality and adherence to the Education Strategy and NRC Program Policy.
- 3. Regular visits to field offices to provide technical support and to ensure that the Education strategy and quality standards are being followed.
- 4. Design and conduct the process for developing / updating the Education strategy for the Education CC
- 5. Participate in project start up and follow up meetings according to assigned responsibilities.
- 6. In coordination with Education teams and Area Managers at field level identify training needs for the education staff
- 7. Design and conduct training sessions with the education staff according to the identified needs.
- 8. Develop technical documents to communicate key process in the implementation of the education strategy to the education staff.
- 9. Identify the needs to conduct internal reviews and / or evaluations for Education activities / Strategy.
- 10. Ensure the proper filing of information related to the Education Strategy.
- 11. Ensure integration of SIP in the education CC.
